



THE THREAT FROM IRAN

AMERICAN PUBLIC OPINION ON IRAN

Three recent national polls were conducted to gauge the American public's opinion on Iran. Below are questions and answers from those surveys.

QUINNIPIAC POLL

From December 3 - 9, Quinnipiac University surveyed 2,692 registered voters nationwide with a margin of error of +/- 1.9 percentage points.

The Interim Agreement

As you may know, Iran has agreed to limit its nuclear program in exchange for lighter economic sanctions. Do you support or oppose this nuclear deal reached with Iran?

Support: 44% • Oppose: 46%

American Safety

Do you think this deal with Iran will make the United States safer or less safe?

Safer: 37% • Less Safe: 45%

Israel's Safety

Do you think this deal with Iran will make Israel safer or less safe?

Israel safer: 29% • Less safe: 52%

PEW RESEARCH CENTER AND USA TODAY

From December 3-8, Princeton Data Source polled a national sample of 2,001 adults with a margin of error of +/- 2.6 percentage points.

The Interim Agreement

From what you know, do you approve or disapprove of the agreement between the United States and Iran on Iran's nuclear program?

Approve: 32% • Disapprove: 43%

Iran's Seriousness

Do you think Iranian leaders are serious about addressing international concerns about their country's nuclear enrichment program, or not? (asked to those who indicated they heard a lot or a little about the interim agreement)

December 3-8 (After Interim Deal)

Serious: 29% • Not Serious: 62%

October 30-Nov 6 (Before Interim Deal)

Serious: 33% • Not Serious: 60%


From December 7-9, 2013, Luntz Global surveyed 900 likely voters with a margin of error of +/- 3.3 percentage points.

Party Divide

Thinking of all the elections that you vote in, would you say that you generally vote for...?

Democrats: 38% • Swing: 28% • Republicans: 33%

Do you support or oppose lifting economic sanctions against Iran if they continue to sponsor terrorism?



Trusting Iran

Overall, do you TRUST or DISTRUST the current Iranian government when they say their nuclear program is exclusively peaceful and they do not seek nuclear weapons?

Trust: 7% • Distrust: 77%

What Will Iran Do?

After over a decade of mounting international sanctions, Iran and six major powers announced a first-step deal in November 2013 that aims to slow parts of Iran's nuclear program in exchange for relief of financial pressure and easing of various economic sanctions while negotiating a final agreement. First, if you had to guess, do you think Iran will ...?

Do What it Promises: 14% • Break its Promises: 86%

Iran's Plan

Which of the following [two] statements about Iran comes CLOSEST to your view?

Iran is using these negotiations to stall as it continues to develop its ability to make nuclear weapons: 84%

Iran is negotiating in good faith and will eventually give up their ability to make nuclear weapons: 16%
