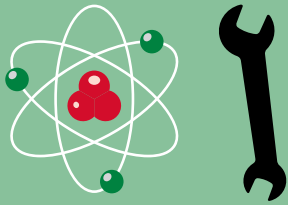


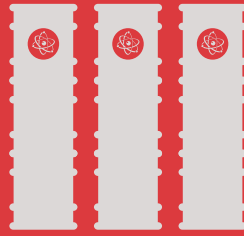
WHAT'S THE DEAL?

An agreement based on the announced framework would allow Iran to become a nuclear threshold state within 15 years.



DISMANTLEMENT

Apart from the core at Arak, Iran will not dismantle its nuclear infrastructure.



CENTRIFUGES

Iran will be allowed to operate over 6,000 centrifuges, and can continue research and development on more advanced centrifuge models.



SECRET ENRICHMENT SITE

Iran will not close its illicit underground facility at Fordow, and will be allowed to develop enrichment technology.



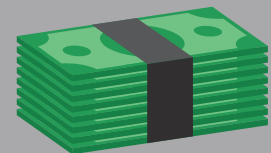
INSPECTIONS

It is unclear if inspectors will have access to all suspect nuclear sites.



POSSIBLE MILITARY DIMENSIONS

The proposed framework is ambiguous about how and when Iran will address its past weaponization efforts.



SANCTIONS

It is uncertain how quickly sanctions would be lifted over time, or re-imposed if Iran violates an agreement.

10-15
YEARS

DURATION

When nuclear restrictions are lifted in 10-15 years, Iran could have the capacity to produce weapons-grade uranium for a bomb within days.

THE BEST PATH FORWARD

Congress must review any agreement and insist on a **good deal**.

Urge members of Congress to support the **Iran Nuclear Agreement Review Act of 2015**.
