IDF officer stabbed and wounded near Nablus; assailant shot and killed

A suspected terrorist lightly wounded an Israeli officer on Thursday after stabbing him on the hand on the slopes of Mount Ebal near Nablus located in the West Bank, reports The Jerusalem Post. The assailant was shot and killed following the incident. The incident marks the second terrorist attack of the day. Earlier on Thursday, a suspected terrorist was shot and killed by Israeli security forces after attempting to stab a soldier at the Beit Einoun junction located close to the Kiryat Arba settlement and the West Bank city of Hebron. No Israelis were injured in the event. The incident is the latest in a string of violent attacks against Israelis who have been the target of Palestinian violence over the last three months.
