4 killed, 3 badly injured, in central Tel Aviv shooting terror attack

Four people were killed in a shooting terror attack in Tel Aviv's popular Sarona Market Wednesday evening. Three others were seriously hurt. Police said two Palestinian gunmen were involved in the terror attack. According to The Times of Israel, both gunman were in custody Wednesday night. Police later confirmed they are Palestinian relatives, 21-year-old cousins, from the Hebron area in the West Bank. According to The Jerusalem Post, the United States condemned the attack and referred to it as a "cowardly" and "horrific" act of terror. The statement reads, "The United States condemns today's horrific terrorist attack in Tel Aviv in the strongest possible terms...These cowardly attacks against innocent civilians can never be justified."
