Biden Condemns Palestinian Terror Attacks

Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas this week praised as a “martyr” a young Palestinian woman who attempted to kill an IDF soldier with her car, reports The Times of Israel. “We see in her a martyr who watered the pure earth of Palestine with her blood,” he wrote in a letter to the parents of Amani Husni Sabatin, 34, from the Palestinian village of Husan, near Bethlehem. Abbas’s letter came as U.S. Vice President, Joe Biden, was visiting Israel and the West Bank for meetings with Israeli as well as Palestinian leaders. On Wednesday, just one day after a Palestinian terrorist stabbed to death American graduate student, Taylor Force, and wounded nine others, including Force’s wife, in Jaffa, Biden criticized the Palestinian leadership’s “failure to condemn” terror attacks.
