- Iran has repeatedly violated the U.N. Charter by calling for the destruction of Israel, a fellow member of the world body.
- As the United States and the EU are seeking to pressure Hamas for its refusal to recognize Israel and end terrorism, Iran has funneled \$120 million since January to fund Hamas ministers and security forces.
- Palestinian Authority President Mahmoud Abbas has repeatedly complained to foreign nations about Iran's intervention in internal Palestinian affairs and has sent top aides to press Hizballah to stop providing funds to Palestinian terrorist groups.
- Hizballah-trained militias in Iraq are using Iranian-supplied weapons such as advanced improvised explosive devices and anti-tank weapons to attack and kill American soldiers in Iraq.
- U.S. intelligence reportedly believes that Iranian operatives provided al-Qaeda in the 1990s with key weapons training and tactical advice. Iran, which aided the transit of al Qaeda operatives, including the travels of several 9/11 hijackers, reportedly is sheltering al Qaeda terrorists today.
- In October 2006, Argentinian prosecutors issued indictments of senior Iranian leaders – including former President Hashemi Rafsanjani – for masterminding the 1994 bombing of the Jewish community center in Buenos Aires.
- In October 2005, Iranian President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad called for the destruction of countries that recognize Israel, including Jordan and Egypt, saying, “Anybody who recognizes Israel will burn in the fire of the Islamic nation’s fury.”
